
Behavior Analysis History Chart



Many important books and articles were published during this period—Sidman's Tactics of Scientific Research (1960), Ullman and Krasner's Case Studies in Behavior Modification, (1965). There were also a number of important organizational events (e.g., Division 25 of APA was formed, behavioral academic programs got started at University of Washington (Bijou), Arizona State University (Staats), Southern Illinois University (Sulzer, Azrin,); Kansas University (Baer, Wolf, Risley etc.) and others.
